What H.R. 1024 Would Require

- Better label at the pump
 - Include the word "warning"
 - Focus group tested
 - Industry input
 - Larger size and font
 - Pictograms
- New EPA public education campaign
- New coordination between EPA and state boarding registration entities
- Resolution on marketing for unleaded 88

95% of boats are trailerable and fueled at local gas stations

- 142 million boaters take to the water annually, consuming about 2.3 million gallons of gasoline.
- Boats, motorcycles, lawnmowers, and many other consumer products are federally prohibited from using
- Misfuelling with E15 results in performance degradation, emission increases, fuel leaks, engine failure, and voids manufacturer warranties.
- 3 in 5 consumers mistakenly assume that E15 is safe for all their products.
- 9 in 10 Americans believe the government must do more to protect consumers from the dangers of E15.
